Several executive committee members and I attended the Department of Maryland Legion Convention in Ocean City, where Post 60 was honored with multiple awards. Notably, we received the 100% Membership Award - my sincere appreciation goes to Lee Luby for her dedicated service and hard work in helping us reach this milestone. Additionally, our SAL was named Squadron of the Year for District 5. We also earned second place as top donor for our contribution to the Maryland Gold Star Legacy Run to benefit the Children's Foundation, raising over \$20,000 as a legion family. For the fourteenth consecutive year, we were recognized for producing the Best Newsletter. John Musgrove consistently delivers an outstanding publication each month with assistance from our proofreaders.

I am deeply honored to have received the Legionnaire of the Year award. This recognition reflects the many achievements our post accomplished throughout the 2024-2025 year. Although the award was presented to me, it is truly a testament to the collective efforts of our entire post family. Post 60 is fortunate to have committed volunteers and members who are dedicated to supporting our veterans and advancing the mission of the American Legion. Our Post family has worked diligently to raise funds and organize events, all for the betterment of our post. The Auxiliary would like to congratulate our very own Post 60 Commander, Josie Lohman, for receiving the Legionnaire of the Year award and Sons of the American Legion for having the Best SAL Program in District 5. These are just a few of the many awards that Post 60 were given and many thanks to all of the members that helped make those happen.

With Convention over, our Membership drive is in full swing. Dues for the 2026 year are \$35.00, \$10.00 for Junior members (17 and under), and \$25.00 for dual members (dual members must renew at the Post to receive the discount). You can renew your membership in several ways. Preprinted cards are available at the post, please ask for myself (Carolyn Monko), Lee Luby, or Tris Thomas, and we will be glad to help you. You can call National Headquarters at (317) 569-4570 with your member ID and speak with a real person that can walk you through the process.

Another option to renew your membership is online at <https://www.legion-aux.org/renew>. You will need to create an account using your membership ID, which can be found on the upper right-hand side of your membership card, and you can renew and print out your card online. If you have not created an account, please do so and look around the website at the exciting programs and ways that the Auxiliary helps our Veterans, active-duty Military members, Children, and our Community. It really is a "rabbit hole" of information with lots of ways to become informed and involved both locally and nationally.

Another perk of early renewal is the American Legion Family Early Bird Appreciation Social on October 12 from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. All members who have renewed in their Early Bird time frames will be given a complimentary drink wristband. Also included are light fare and cash drawings every 15 minutes.

Our next meeting is August 11th at 7:00 p.m. at the Post. We will be having a reception at 6:00 with a light dinner to meet the young ladies that we sponsored for Girls State this past summer. They will be sharing their experiences of learning about citizenship, leadership, and Americanism and ways that the program has impacted them personally.

We will also be kicking off our program to educate and learn more about Auxiliary programs on a national and local level. Each year, the Auxiliary files Unit Reports for each

of the areas that we support. Those reports include information on programs, volunteer hours, and military and community members served. These reports help to gain recognition and support from Congress and are an important part of our mission. There are 14 categories and many sub-categories.

We will be starting off with Education which will coincide with our "Give 10 to Education" program. This program encourages participants to donate school supplies for the upcoming school year. To make it easy on the donors, we ask that you give 10 of a needed supply, such as 10 boxes of crayons or 10 boxes of tissues. We will have a collection bin in the lobby and send out lists of needed materials. No donation is too small for these children to get them well prepared for the school year.

Other programs under Education include; Veterans in the Classroom; National Education Week, Teacher Appreciation Week, School Awards, and the Crystal Apple Award. And we will have a brief review of ways to participate.

Keep saving those pop-tops/pull tabs from your aluminum cans or beverage containers. These will be donated to the Ronald McDonald House through various local organizations (girl scouts, etc.).

It's not too late to have a little summer fun! The Unit is hosting Bar Bingo Fun Nights on Wednesday evenings starting at 6:00 with Bingo, Pull-Tabs, and Winey Wednesday special prices. Bring the family and friends, everybody has a great time.

Every Tuesday the Craft Club will be getting together to make a unique and fun craft with friends. The next one will be Tuesday, August 12th from 6 to 9:00 p.m. They will be making Kumihimo braided bracelets. 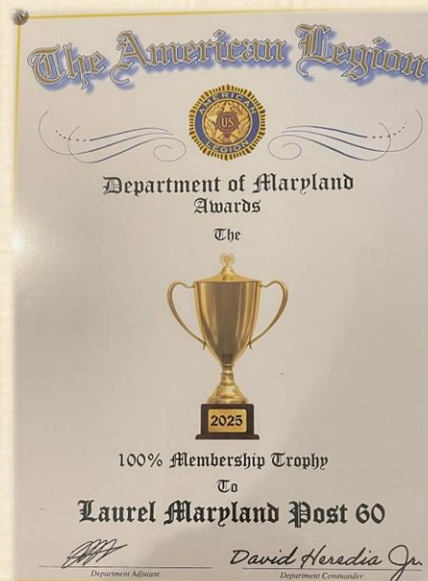

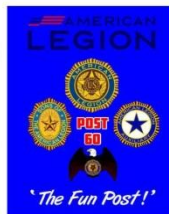
